ABOUT US

Skånesten have long and high level of experience in stonework. Skånesten performs all types of stonework for companies and private individuals.

One of the company's founders Jonas Svensson started as an apprentice at his father's company in the mid 90`s. Jonas father is retired but was one of Sweden's best stonemasons and Jonas is taking his place. The two of them worked together in one of Sweden's biggest stone construction companies and they also worked for NCC Construction, one of Sweden's biggest construction companies.

Skånesten started in the mid-2000s with a focus on stonework, but in recent years has expanded operations within the construction and building maintenance segments, preferably restauration of historical buildings.

The company employees Swedish, Portuguese and Rumanian stoneworkers, all highly skilled in their respective area. Depending on the season and the business cycle we employ about 4-14 stonemasons. We operate in all of Sweden but mainly in the south, Skåne county and Västra Götaland county mainly in Gothenburg.

Some of our stoneworkers are contracted outside Sweden, for example in Los Angeles and France.

OUR SERVICES

We work with natural stone and concrete stone. We work indoors and outdoors.

Skånesten has experience with different types of stone like SLATE, MARBLE, LIME STONE, GRANITE, TILES (PORCELAIN, CLAY, CERAMIC), BRICKS, SANDSTONE and different types of CONCRETE TILES AND PAVING STONES.

WE OFFER:

Stone-setting of different tiles like concrete, granite, porcelain and more.

Stone-setting of Belgian block (sett), cobblestone, kerb and more.

Stone veneer of different types of stone like granite, limestone, slate and more.

Stairs of different types of stones.

Open Fireplace.

Stonewalls with mortar or dry stone walls and rubble stone walls.

HISTORICAL BUILDINGS:

The company has a high degree of know-how in working on historical buildings like castles, mansions, churches and so forth. We work indoors and outdoors restoring different types of stonework mostly stairs, floors and fasads. We clean old natural stone using techniques that does not damage or alter the stone in any way.

We have done restauration for the Swedish church and some of the biggest restauration companies in Sweden specializing in historical buildings.

The two walls lead visitors onto the driveway for the main building of the stable.
The two walls are approximately 30 meters long and 1 meter high.

The stone is granite and was hand-picked by our team in a local quarry to ensure the best quality off the stone, both visually and building wise.

The mountain on the hill where the pool area is located was blasted in order to fit the pool. The stone (rock cut) from the blasting was used to build the stone walls around the pool area.



The stairs leading up to the main building is lime stone.

Here lives a stork family.

In 2018 Skånesten restored the retaining wall (dry stone wall) surrounding the moat at Tomarps Kungsgård, for Svevia AB.

The moat was drained and the fishes living in the moat was stored in big water tanks and put back after the restauration was complete. The old stone was reused when the wall was built up again. Approximately 100 meters was restored and the wall is about 1,5 meters high and 1 meter wide. Tomparps Kungsgård is a historical building owned by the Swedish government.



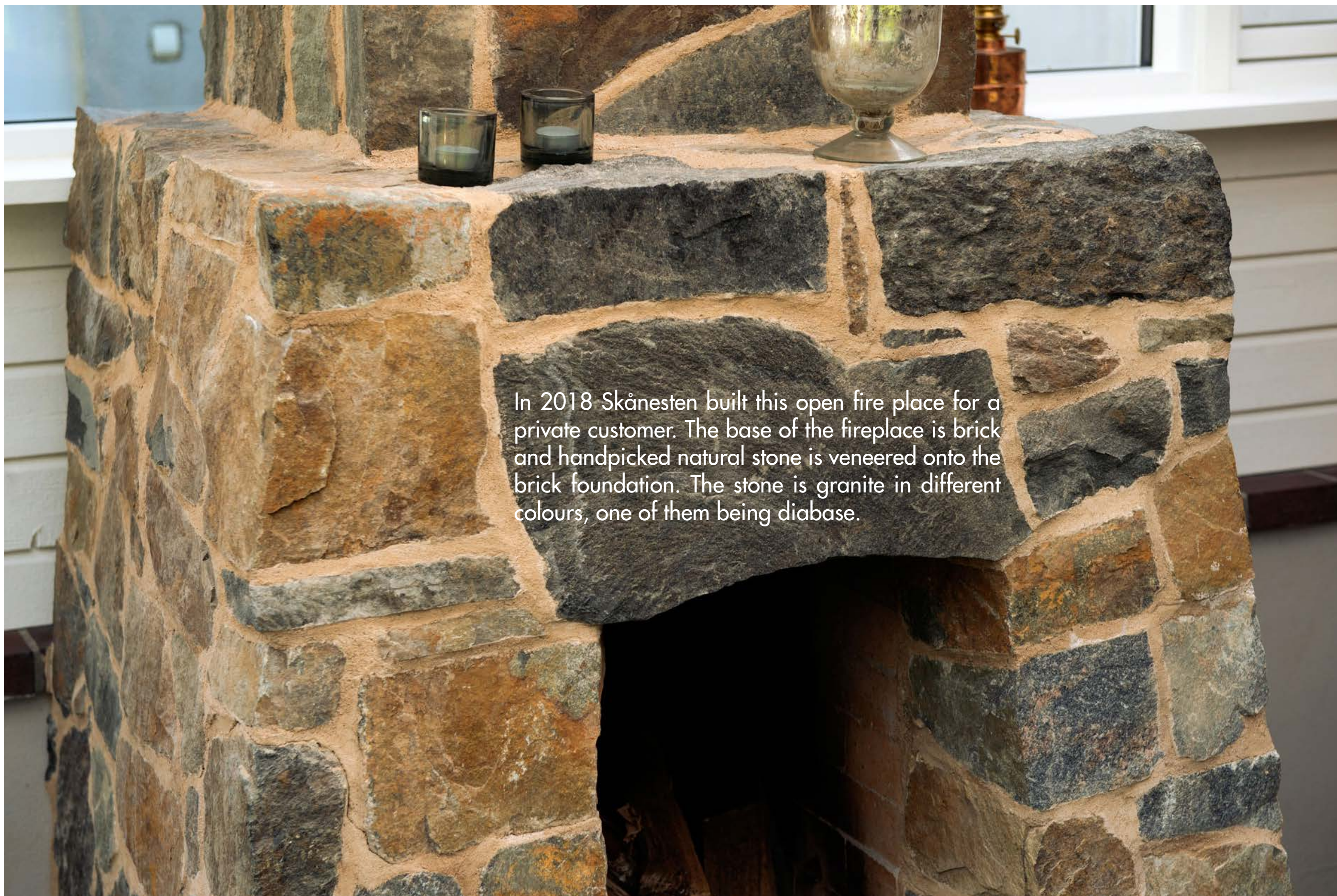




Between 2018 - 2020 Skånensten restored several stone walls surrounding Vallkärra Kyrka, both dry stone walls and stone walls with mortar. The contractor was the Swedish church in Lund and an antiquarian was commissioned by the church too oversee and write a report about the restorations. Approximately 250 meter stone wall was restored, among them a dry stone wall that reached over 2 meters high. One of the stone walls with mortar was completely taken down and rebuilt with mortar. The old stone was reused but some new stone was used from a nearby quarry to match the old stone. New stone was used because the old was a risk factor for the stability of the walls.

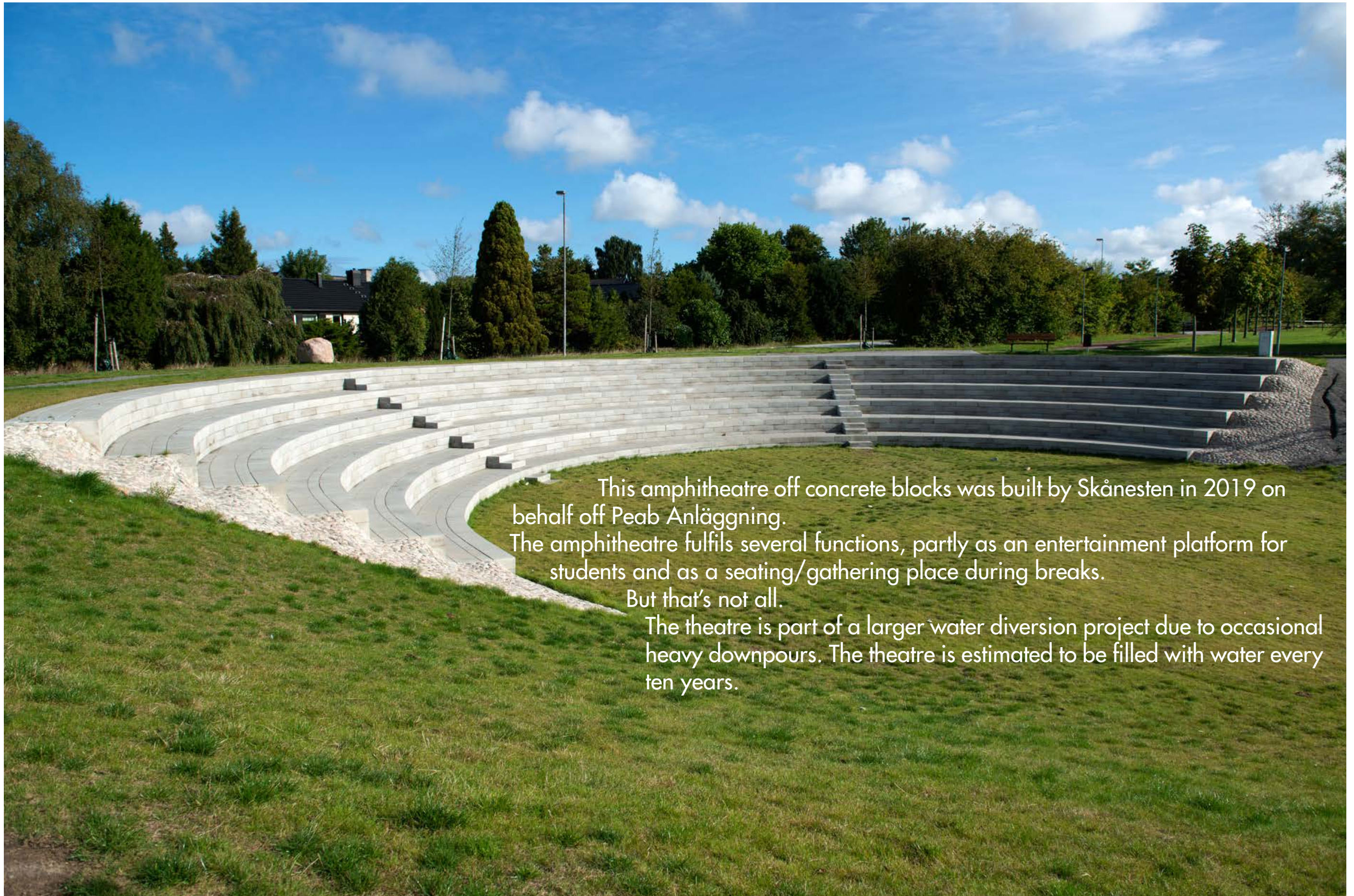






In 2018 Skånesten built this open fire place for a private customer. The base of the fireplace is brick and handpicked natural stone is veneered onto the brick foundation. The stone is granite in different colours, one of them being diabase.



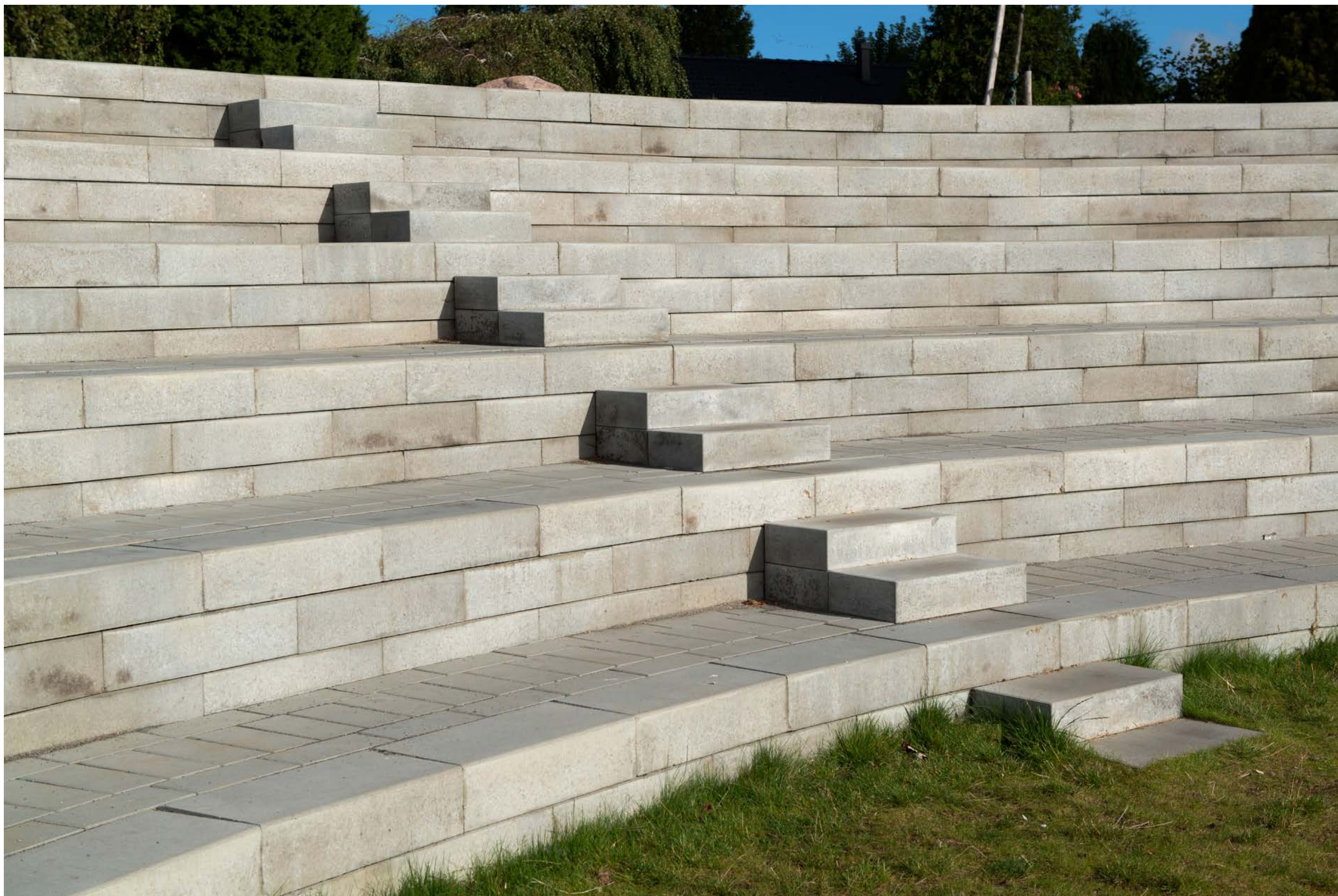


This amphitheatre off concrete blocks was built by Skånesten in 2019 on behalf off Peab Anläggning.

The amphitheatre fulfils several functions, partly as an entertainment platform for students and as a seating/gathering place during breaks.

But that's not all.

The theatre is part of a larger water diversion project due to occasional heavy downpours. The theatre is estimated to be filled with water every ten years.







In 2021 Skånesten was contracted by Stucco Maestro to restore the fasad on Caroli Church.

The natural stone on the base and the entrance was taken down, cleaned and then put back. In some cases the stone was too damaged to reuse so new stone was made, an exact replica of the old stone, and put back. The church is an historical building and an antiquarian was involved.





Stone veneer on fasad

Skånesten was contracted to restore and repair the fasad on Arlöv church. Various kind of stone veneering was made around the church. Most of the natural stone (sandstone) was to damaged/old too reuse so new stone was made. Arlöv church is an historical building and an antiquarian was involved.

The sandstone on the steeples was taken down and new stone was veneered back and grouted.

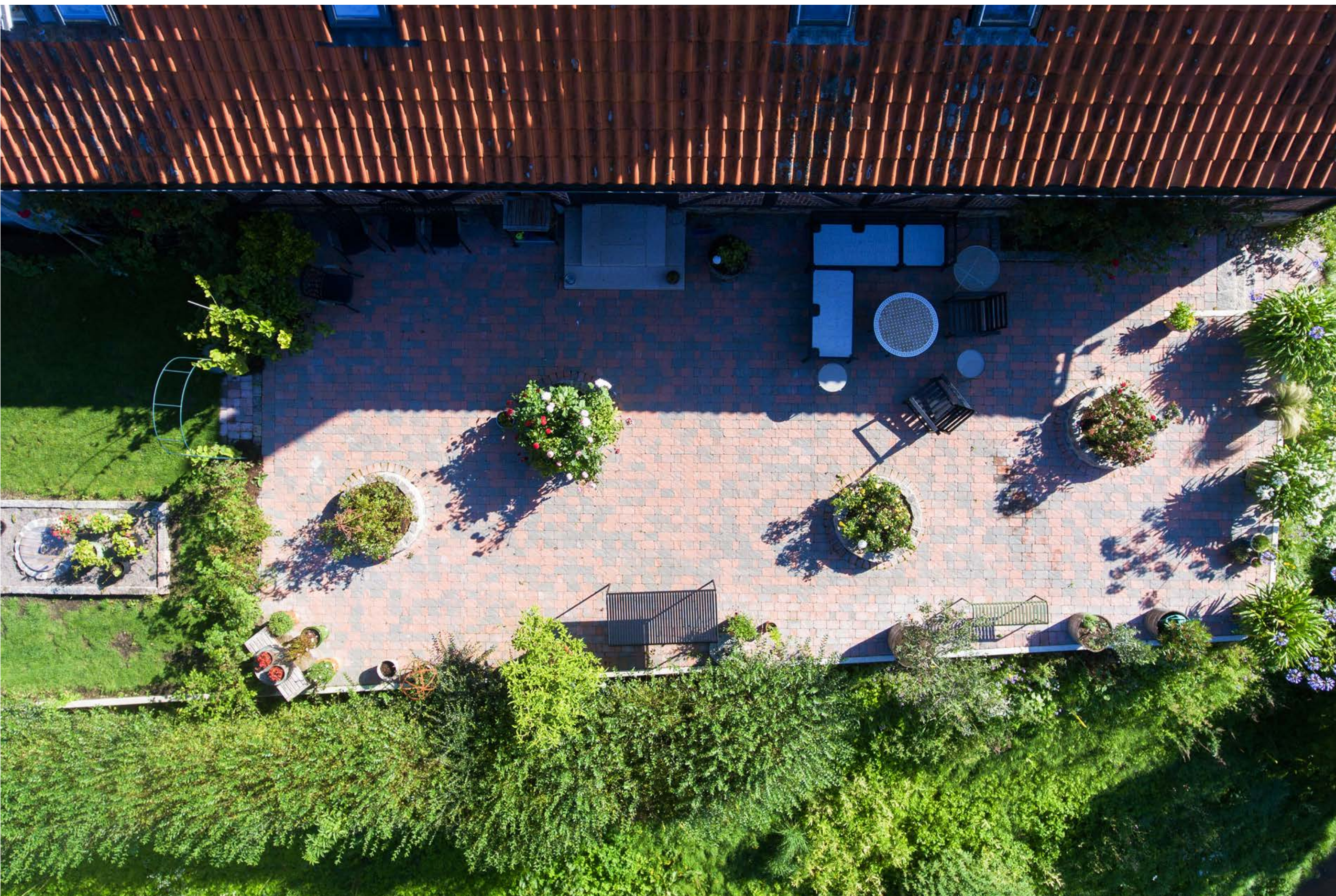

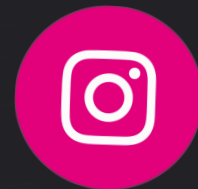
